(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new gas supply, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Eythorne Road, Shepherdswell, near Dover.

A closure is planned from Monday 13 January 2020 for an estimated period of up to 5 days.

Eythorne Road will be closed in the general vicinity of number 40A, with no access between the junctions with The Glen and Penfold Gardens.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Church Hill, Mill Lane, Great Haynes and Shepherdswell Road.

Local access to the remainder of Eythorne Road continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

There is a chance that the planned dates may change, and updated information can be found on one.network – [SGN Gas Permit XW046W116624449-00465], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
