CANTERBURY ROAD, LYDDEN

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Canterbury Road, Lydden will be closed to through traffic, on or after 5th October 2020 for up to 5 days.

The road will be closed at Swanton Lane to the railway bridge.

The alternative route is via London Road, A256 Whitfield Hill, A2 Dover Road and Lydden Hill.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 09.30 hrs and 15.30 hrs each day.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway maintenance to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
