**EYTHORNE ROAD, SHEPHERDSWELL**

**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2020**

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new gas supply, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Eythorne Road, Shepherdswell, in the Dover area.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 9 November 2020, with estimated completion by 13 November 2020.

Eythorne Road will be closed in the general vicinity of number 45, with no through access between the junctions with The Glen and Penfold Gardens.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Eythorne Road, Coxhill, A2 Dover Road, Coldred Hill, Church Road, Coldred Road, Sandwich Road, Wigmore Lane and Shepherdswell Road.

Local access to the remainder of Eythorne Road continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.
