CANTERBURY ROAD, LYDDEN, DOVER

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2020

To allow works to be carried out to remove a dangerous tree near the railway line, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Canterbury Road, Lydden, Dover.

A closure is currently planned for Wednesday 25 November 2020 from 08:00 hours to approximately 16:00 hours.

Canterbury Road will be closed west of the railway bridge, to the actual extent indicated on site.

~ There will be no direct access between the Dover and Lydden during these works ~

The alternative route for through traffic is via London Road, A256 Whitfield Hill, Whitfield Roundabout, A2 Dover Road and Lydden Hill back to Canterbury Road.

Local access to the remainder of Canterbury Road / London Road continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation, and updated information can be found on www.one.network – [Network Rail Permit KL870FDM-74-05-251120], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
