(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow repairs to be carried out to overhead phone cables, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Coldred Road, Shepherdswell, near Dover.

Off-peak closures are planned from 2 December 2020 for up to 2 days, between 09:30 hours and approximately 15:30 hours each day.

Coldred Road will be closed between the junctions with Mill Lane and Upton Wood Road, to the actual extent shown on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Mill Lane, Great Haynes, Coldred Road, Church Road and Coldred Road.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation, and updated information can be found on www.one.network – [BT Openreach Permit BC00804JANIBUDW1PX], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
