MILL LANE, SHEPHERDSWELL, DOVER

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow essential carriageway repairs and resurfacing to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Mill Lane, Shepherdswell, near Dover.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 23 November 2020 for up to 2 days.

Mill Lane will be closed between the junctions with Long Lane and Little Haynes, to the actual extent indicated on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Coldred Road, Church Road, Coldred Road and Long Lane, and vice versa.

Local access to the residential section of Mill Lane continues from a southern direction up to where the road is actually closed.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation, and updated information can be found on www.one.network – [Kent County Council Permit GE40143024920], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
