COXHILL, SHEPHERDSWELL, DOVER

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow telecoms ducting and cabling works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Coxhill, Shepherdswell, near Dover.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 14 December 2020, with estimated completion by 18 December 2020.

Coxhill will be closed in the general vicinity of Diamond Farm, to the actual extent shown on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via A2 Dover Road, Coldred Hill, Church Road, Coldred Road, Sandwich Road, Wigmore Lane, Shepherdswell Road and Eythorne Road back to Coxhill.

Local access to the remainder of Coxhill continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation, and updated information can be found on www.one.network – [BT Openreach Permit BC111WBNGDF4G001], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
