DENTON LANE, WOOTTON, DOVER
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new water connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Denton Lane, Wootton, in the Dover area.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 10 May 2021 for an estimated period of up to 5 days.

Denton Lane will be closed towards its eastern end, to the actual extent shown on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via A260 Canterbury Road, Stockham Lane and Wootton Lane.

Access to the village of Wootton is via the above diversion.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
